Aftercare

After you complete the discipleship program, we will still be there to support you, especially if you find yourself struggling to maintain your new way of life. We are committed to standing with you and helping you get established.

We are funded solely by our local church and caring individuals. We are not connected in any way with local, state or federal governments.

We are a discipleship home, not a homeless shelter, or a psychiatric, medical or drug treatment facility. We are not a half-way house or an alternative to incarceration.

We cannot admit people who have significant psychiatric issues or illnesses/disabilities that would prevent them from participating in the home's overall agenda of activities.

Residents struggling with chemical addictions must be drug- and alcohol-free for at least 30 days prior to entering the home. Proof must be provided.

Hope for the Hurting's 6- to 9-month Bible-based discipleship program is designed to help you overcome personal obstacles as you grow in your relationship with God.

We don't offer "quick-fixes." Lasting change takes time and patience. Some people may need to learn a whole new way of thinking and living to fully enjoy new life in Christ.

Topics of our Christ-centered instruction include:

- Understanding your salvation
- The father heart of God
- Developing a relationship with God
- Walking in new life
- Finding self-worth in Christ
- Healing from abuse
- Freedom from anger, guilt, shame, unforgiveness, etc., through Jesus
- Purity in Christian living

You will also receive **general Bible teaching**, some of it through church services and Bible studies at Bethany Revival Center in Wichita, KS.

Life-skills training includes:

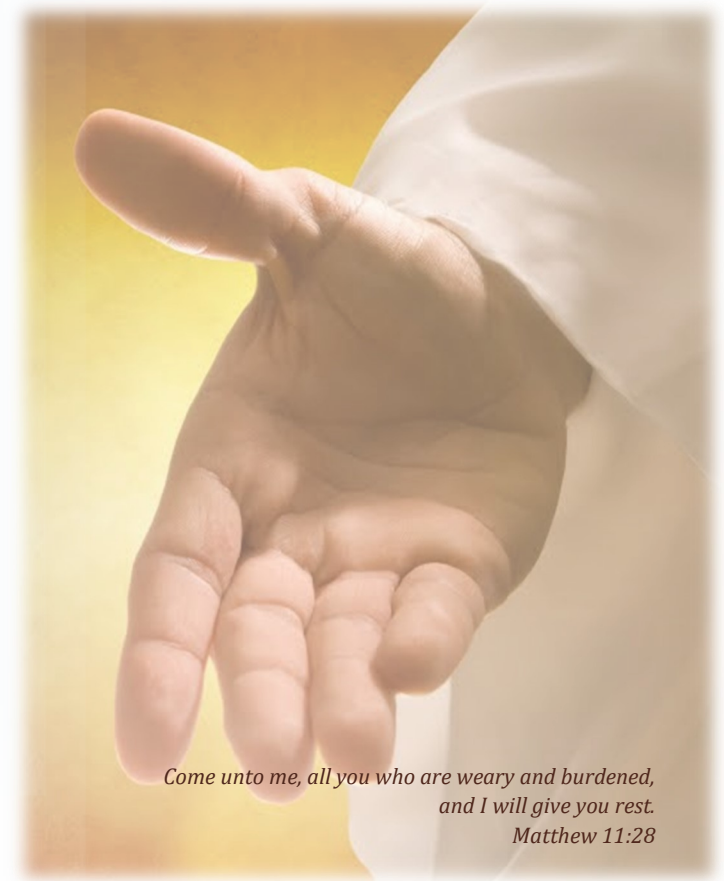
- Family life
- Parenting
- Home Economics
- Managing finances
- Preparation for GED testing
- Finding a job, preparing resumes, interviewing, etc.

Other regular activities include crafts, gardening, work detail, volunteering in the community and participating in community events. In addition, we schedule recreational opportunities and offer a fitness room and library.

Costs

Residents with no outside income live at the discipleship home free of charge until they become employed.

Those with resources such as food stamps or disability payments will contribute their food stamps and a portion of their other funds to cover some costs of operating the home.
